February 5, 2015 e-Vote Minutes

Background:

On February 2, 2015, the CVBC office realized that Council didn't vote for suspension of licences for non-payment of annual registration fees. Therefore, the following motions were distributed for an e-vote:

Motions:

MOTION 1: (February 2, 2015)

MOTION that the following registrants were denied a waiver for the late payment of their 2015 dues, therefore, payment is due on or before <date>. Failure to pay the late fees within the specified time will result in the registrant's licence being suspended:

- Dr. Samardeep Bassi
- Dr. Sarah Begbie
- Dr. Allan Berrington
- Dr. Rikke Danoe
- Dr. Sukhvinder Dhillon

There was a unanimous vote to accept the motion.

TO CORRECT MOTION #1: On February 5, 2015 the Deputy Registrar sent the following to Council:

MOTION THAT Council rescinds Motion #1 to the e-vote of February 2, 2015.

On February 10, 2015, there was unanimous consent by e-mail by all Council members.

MOTION (February 5, 2015):

MOTION THAT the following two registrants are denied a waiver for the late payment of their 2015 annual registration fee and therefore payment is due on or before <date> of the motion passed by Council. Council directs the registrar to suspend the registration of each named registrant to this Motion, who fails to pay the late payment fee within the specified time:

- Dr. Allan Berrington
- Dr. Sukhvinder Dhillon

Note: Subsequent to the original motion, it was discovered that Drs. Bassi and Begbie had resigned.

MOTION THAT the following registrant's request for a waiver for the late payment of his 2015 annual registration fee is denied and, therefore, Council directs the registrar to not refund the registrant's late payment fee.

On Tuesday, February 10, 2015, there was unanimous consent by e-mail by all Council Members.

Note: subsequent to the original motion, it was discovered that Dr. Danoe had paid her late payment fee.

MOTION 2: February 2, 2015:

MOTION that Council direct Dr. Sheila McDonald to pay the late payment fee in the amount of \$358.75 on or before <date> or her licence will be suspended immediately.

On Monday, February 2, 2015 there was unanimous consent by e-mail by all Council members.

MOTION 3: February 2, 2015:

MOTION THAT the following registrants in the resigned class of registration be directed to pay the let payment fee in the amount of \$348.75 on or before <date>. These registrants resigned after the late fee was assigned and therefore the late payment fee is due and payable. Failure to pay the outstanding amount will result in the balance being recorded in his/her file and will be required to be paid if the registrant wishes to reinstate his/her licence. On Monday, February 2, 2015 there was unanimous consent by e-mail by all Council members.

MOTION 4: February 2, 2015:

MOTION that Council direct Dr. Erika Raines to pay the late payment fee in the amount of \$348.75 on or before <date>. Failure to pay the outstanding amount will result in the balance being recorded in her file and will be required to be paid if the registrant wishes to reinstate her licence. This is in additional to the \$892.50 Practice Inspection Fee that is also outstanding.

On Monday, February 2, 2015 there was unanimous consent by e-mail by all Council members.

Note: Where there is <date> in the motion, that date is the date the motion was passed by Council – i.e. February 2 or February 5. In the case of payments owing, the registrants have been given 10 business days from the date of the motion being passed to pay the required dues/fees before the licence is suspended.


